## 2010-2011 Elementary 6-9 Supply List

We have found that it is easier to maintain supplies when they are used in common. When purchasing the items below, please select the most basic type. Decorated pencils and rulers, for example, are distracting to children and the source of excessive socializing during work time. We recommend that your child enjoy them at home and bring only plain, **undecorated** supplies to school. Homework folders may be decorated but should be the flat, ring-less, 2-pocket type that fits easily into their take-home folders.

Please provide your child with the following supplies on the first day of school. All supplies should be left **unmarked**, as they will be used throughout the year by all students in common.
